

## **Gallery Guidelines**

THE BARN'S GALLERY seeks to present a vibrant and fresh gallery of work as a service to its artist members and the larger community. Below are guidelines and information for artists once their artwork has been accepted or juried into the gallery.

## **Gallery Guidelines**

- All artwork must be for sale.
- All artwork must have an emphasis on professional presentation. The Gallery cannot accept items for hanging using saw-tooth hooks or inadequate wiring.
- All framed works must be properly wired for display.
- The Gallery cannot accept poster frames or tabletop frames.
- Reproductions of original works will be displayed in bins or print racks only.
  Reproductions (which includes Giclees) will not be displayed on the walls.
- Artists are responsible for supplying their own display props. All artwork must remain for sale in the Gallery for the above stated display periods. If a piece sells, you will have the opportunity to replace it with something of similar size and orientation (for wall art).
- The Barn Gallery assumes the right to photograph works on display for publicity, education and archival purposes.
- The Barn reserves the right to refuse any artwork.
